Safety Rules for Research Laboratory

Department of Chemistry Université Laval

- 1. Access to the laboratory is limited to **authorised individuals**.
- **2.** No one must **ever work alone** in a laboratory.
- **3.** It is forbidden to **drink**, **eat and store food** in a laboratory.
- **4.** The use of a **lab-coat** and of **safety goggles** is mandatory. Wearing soft contact lens is permitted when worn with certified anti-splashing **safety goggles**. Open shoes are forbidden.
- 5. It is forbidden to pipet by mouth.
- **6.** Read **the Material Safety Data sheet** or any equivalent document before using any new chemical product and use chemicals in the lab only.
- 7. Immediately report any accident or spill to the Service de sécurité et prévention (tel: 911).
- **8.** Waste such as **glass**, **needles and biologic risk material** must be disposed of in appropriate containers.
- **9. Chemical and solid waste** must be disposed of in appropriate containers.
- **10. Do not accumulate** chemical waste: Call the Comité de gestion des produits chimiques for proper disposal (tel: 7999) (http://www.ssp.ulaval.ca/sgc/risques_chimiques/cueillette).
- **11.** Remove **your protection gloves** and **wash your hands** before exiting the lab.
- **12.** Carry all chemicals **container or on a cart** specifically conceived for this purpose.
